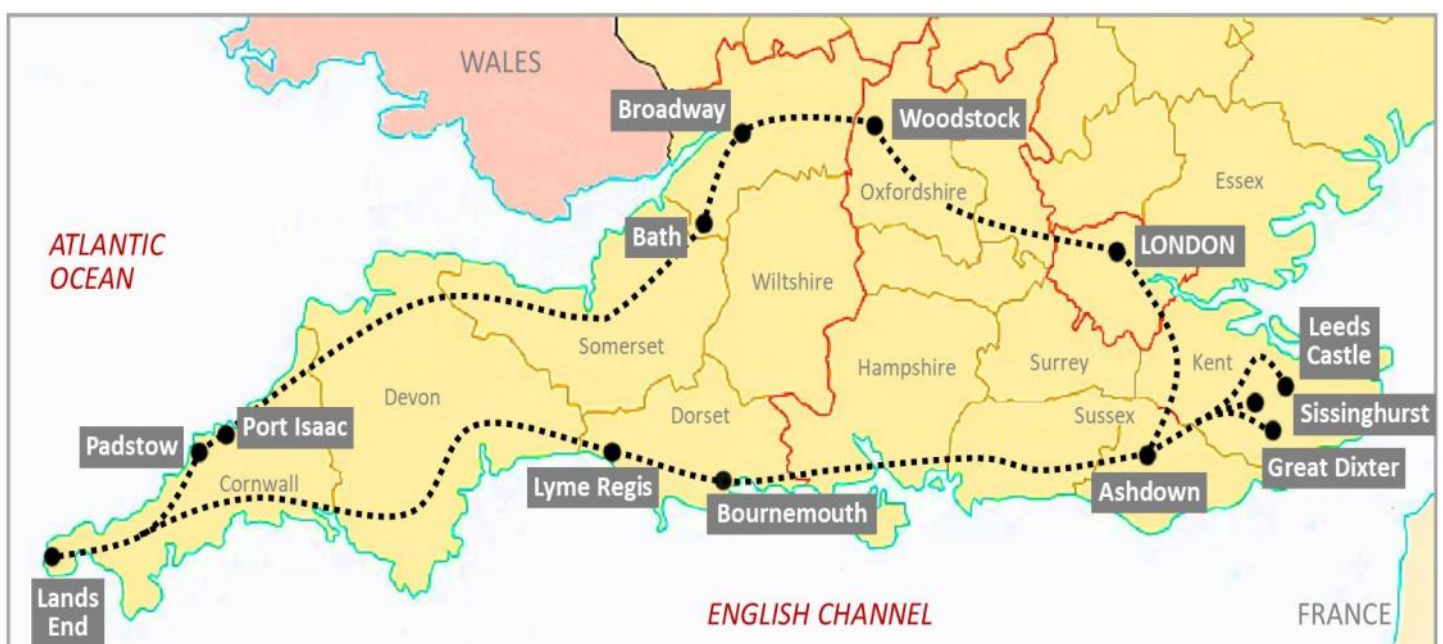

JUNE 2026

Sunday 21 let the fun begin!

We depart Auckland International Airport early afternoon on our big **Singapore Airlines** jet – arriving in **Singapore** in the evening, where we transfer to our hotel on the banks of the **Singapore River** – an easy walk from countless attractions that this glittering Asian showcase-city offers visitors.

Monday 22 on our own in Singapore

(B) After waking and downing a yummy breakfast, we head out together to enjoy a few of Singapore's many attractions: a **Bumboat Cruise** on the Singapore River ... an up-high ride on the **Singapore Flyer** ... a visit to the spectacular **Gardens by the Bay** ... and a legendary **Singapore Sling** (cocktail) in the historic Raffles Hotel.

We return to the hotel mid-afternoon (we've arranged a late-check-out) ... then transfer to the airport for our late-night flight (yawn) to **London**: capital city of 8.8 million and beloved by the world ...

Tuesday 23 hello Woodstock – “in England's green and pleasant land” ...

(D) There's no place in all the world that's quite like England. And, YEEHAA – our long-awaited Garden Path Tour is actually happening! We meet our **Tour Manager** (who will be with us from start-to-finish). Then, leaving London's **Heathrow Airport** and its maddening crowds, we venture forth into the scenic green-and-pleasant backroads of England.

We drive through the wooded Chiltern Hills into historic Oxfordshire and the beautiful village of **Woodstock** – pausing to visit superbly landscaped **Blenheim Palace**, built in 1772, and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill.

'The Bear Hotel' in Woodstock (a 13th century coaching inn) is our home for the next two nights – and we arrive in time for our **Mad Midlife Welcome Dinner**.

Wednesday 24 **The Cotswolds, Bampton & Buscot House**

(B,D)

The day starts (as every day will) with a yummy English breakfast. Then we head out through the gold and green fields of **The Cotswolds** to the quaint village of **Bampton**. Fans of *'Downton Abbey'* will feel the vibes here in this gorgeous town: the location has featured in every episode of that period British drama – so welcome to the regal world of the Crawleys! Long before the TV series – in fact, way back during the Norman Conquest – a large thriving settlement occupied this spot. And Bampton has long been famous for its still-popular Morris Dancing. Bring your violin, bells and hankies – and join in!

Later, we explore **Buscot Park** and its 18th century manor-house, set in enchanting landscaped gardens and housing an impressive art collection.

Feeling hungry? Dinner tonight is at a local Woodstock pub ...

Thursday 25 **Hidcote Manor, Kiftsgate Court & Broadway**

(B,D)

Brace yourselves, Kiwis, because you're about to fall in love! We're going walkabout today in the romantic **Cotswolds**, dropping in on two very famous gardens (their gates opposite each other above the town of Mickleton) ... plus another magical village: **Broadway**, 'Jewel of the Cotswolds' – its streets lined with horse-chestnut trees and picturesque stone cottages.

Hidcote Manor boasts a famous arts-&-crafts inspired garden, created by passionate plantsman, Major Lawrence Johnston. Using the area as a 'blank canvas', he furnished it with exotic rarities gathered during his plant-collecting expeditions around the world, adding colour, scent, shape and texture before eventually gifting Hidcote for future generations to enjoy.

Kiftsgate Court was created by three generations of green-fingered women, and their gardens are famed for hundreds of fragrant old-fashioned roses. 100 years ago a young Heather Muir dreamed of what would become one of the most loved gardens in England. Her daughter Diany took a firm hand to the garden after some neglect during WW2. And Heather's granddaughter, Anne, runs Kiftsgate now – keeping to the spirit of Heather's early plans.

Kiftsgate has an exuberance that allows plants to spill over wavy borders and roses to romp up trees!

Dinner tonight? In the *'The Lygon Arms'* – our 650-year-old hotel for two nights.

Friday 26

More postcard Cotswold Villages

(B)

The Cotswolds is a huge, vibrant, buzzing area, crammed with chocolate-box towns, lively markets, glorious castles, ancient mansions, gastro pubs, historic trails, festivals galore, and breathtaking landscapes of golden stone and rolling green hills.

On our to-do list this morning are more spectacular Cotswold villages: **Stow-on-the-Wold**, **Moreton-in-Marsh**, and **Bourton-on-the-Water** (*don't ya love these names?*) – plus a visit to **Bourton House Garden**, known for its imaginative topiaries and colourful plantings.

Finally, we head back to **Broadway** and our hotel. This picturesque village lies beneath Fish Hill (not sure why it's called that) in Worcestershire (the county, not the savoury sauce) – and has lured visitors for centuries. And, speaking of history, *'The Lygon Arms'* is steeped in the stuff. Oliver Cromwell stayed here during the Civil War, night before the bloody Battle of Worcester – while King Charles 1 had previously used this same hotel (or whatever it was back then) to rally his royalist supporters.

A leisurely evening in the village is now yours – along with whatever takes your fancy for dinner!

Saturday 27

Wiltshire, Castle Coombe & Bath

(B,D)

We're on the move again, folks! And our route takes us first into Wiltshire for a visit to tiny **Castle Coombe Village**, a perfectly preserved slice of medieval history that's frequently used as a film location. The village got its name from an almost-gone castle built in the 12th century.

Next, we immerse ourselves in historic **Bath** – a small, genteel city and one of England's prettiest, famous for its **Roman** remains: like the natural thermal bathhouse (impeccably preserved from the first century AD) ... and its fine examples of **Georgian** architecture: like the hot-springs spa, (popularised in 1704 when Queen Anne and King George began travelling there regularly to 'take the waters' for their healing properties) ... the curved Royal Crescent (30 symmetrical houses) ... the Circus (three curved terraces) ... and the Great Pulteney Bridge's end-to-end shops.

Hungry? Another tasty three-course meal awaits us – plus rooms for two nights in the lovely *'Francis Hotel'*.

Sunday 28

Bath Abbey & Spa

(B)

Do you fancy a lazy morning off? Well, here it is: your chance to relax or go exploring in this flower-filled

town on the banks of the River Avon – with its antiques, curiosity shops and olde-worlde charm. An afternoon walking tour will allow you to enjoy more highlights – including the city’s 2000-year-old Roman-built baths, plus medieval **Bath Abbey**, with a birds-eye view of the city from its tower.

While you’re wandering, keep a lookout for Bath’s oldest teahouse (dated 1482) down an alleyway near the Abbey, where the famous fluffy buns known as ‘Sally Lunn’s’ were first baked! *(Remember them, with that slab of pink icing?)*

Evening at leisure to enjoy one of Bath’s many wonderful restaurants and pubs!

Monday 29

Devon, Cornwall, Port Isaac & Padstow

(B,D)

This morning, once we’ve made our beds, buttered our toast, and cleaned our teeth, we venture out through **Devon** and **Cornwall** into England’s Wild West. Shaped by the mighty Atlantic, this is the land of Arthurian myths, a haven for Celtic culture, and a paradise for nature-lovers and foodies. Expect to see stunning beaches, granite moorlands, cosy villages and ancient castles. And expect to hear tales of not-so-chivalric knights, canny smugglers and hell-hounds!

On the way, we visit the tiny harbour of **Port Isaac** (setting for the hit TV series ‘**Doc Martin**’). And **Tintagel Village** with the remains of a 13th century castle – all shrouded in myths and legends about King Arthur and his Knights of the Round Table.

Late afternoon, we arrive in the seaside resort of **Padstow** – on the beautiful Carmel Estuary, 450 kms from London. This ancient port (fishing and boat-building are still a big part of the economy) has seen its popularity boosted by celebrity chef, **Rick Stein**, who owns four different eateries in Padstow. His waterfront Seafood Restaurant has been here for 40 years, promising fish and shellfish that’s fresher than fresh!

You’ll love this place, folks – and you’ll love ‘**The Metropole Hotel**’, where we’ll be for the next four nights. We dine together tonight in one of Padstow’s classic eateries.

Tuesday 30

Padstow at leisure

(B,D)

Padstow’s too nice to go rushing through like exhausted tourists, so we’ve got the day off: to enjoy this unique seaside location to the full ... wander the waterfront with its colourful fishing boats and pleasure craft ... do some souvenir

shop-shop-shopping ... book a wildlife trip to spot seals, dolphins and puffins ... go bird-watching at low-tide ... or find a seat and eat an icecream, or lie in the grass and watch clouds go by!

Just don't lose track of time: another slap-up dinner awaits us tonight in our hotel restaurant or down in the village.

JULY 2026

Wednesday 1 **St Ives by the Sea – at Lands' End**

(B) **St Ives** – *“the diamond in Cornwall’s crown”* – is voted one of England’s most beautiful seaside villages, with its picture-perfect waterfront and boat-harbour, its maze of narrow cobbled streets, renowned art scene, stunning coastal walks, and quartet of golden surf beaches. Our visit includes the Barbara Hepworth Museum and Sculpture Garden. Then we continue to **Lands’ End** for stunning views of the rugged, wave-battered cliffs that protect England’s most south westerly tip – and the wild Atlantic Ocean that stretches to the horizon. A touristy complex records exploits-of-old in the wild seas, and insights into the modern air-sea rescue service.

We return to Padstow for an evening of food and leisure at a local pub or restaurant (your call).

Thursday 2 **Cornwall’s lost gardens & tropical jungles**

(B,D) If you enjoy mysteries, you’re gonna love today! The **Lost Gardens of Heligan** is one of the most mysterious estates in the UK. Buried under the brambles of time since the outbreak of WW1, this Sleeping Beauty was re-awakened in 1990 to become Europe’s largest garden restoration project.

Today Heligan’s 200 acres are a dreamy paradise for plant-lovers and romantics.

Later, we explore a sub-tropical jungle in yet another Cornwall creation: the stunning **Trebah Gardens** – canopies bursting with exotic blooms and tunnels of colour cascading down to a private beach.

We dine together again tonight – maybe time to try the local tradition: fresh-caught fish’n’chips?

Friday 3 **Dorset & Lyme Regis**

(B,D) We’re on the move today – this time to **Bournemouth** and the **‘Highcliff Marriott’**, (our hotel for the next two nights).

But first, a question: Are you into fossils and really old rocks? Well, stay alert –

because we're heading through **Dartmoor National Park** to **Dorset** (featuring gorgeous countrysides, thatched-roof cottages, winding flower-filled lanes) and the storm-battered **Jurassic Coast**!

We make a stop on the way at **Lyme Regis**: the pretty coastal town where *The French Lieutenant's Woman* was filmed – and the birthplace of famous palaeontologist and dinosaur-hunter, Mary Anning, who discovered prehistoric skeletons embedded in the ancient cliffs.

Then we make another stop: at beautiful secluded **Lulworth Cove** with its clear blue water and picture-postcard village.

Saturday 4 **Bournemouth at leisure**

(B) When you first set eyes on **Bournemouth's** beautiful beaches, you can easily be forgiven for forgetting you're on England's south coast. Because this nearly 15 km-long stretch of sugar-white sand wouldn't look out of place on the Mediterranean – or in Florida – or in New Zealand!

Bournemouth regularly clocks up seaside awards, with its long, long promenade backed by 3000 deckchairs ... 200 multi-hued beach huts ... two famous piers ... a museum ... an art gallery ... an oceanarium ... ornamental gardens ... and more.

We have the day off today – *whoopee-doo!* A chance to stroll the shoreline, lie in the sun, soak in the sea, and enjoy Bournemouth's offerings at our leisure – with dinner on our own this evening: a choice of local café food or fine-dining, or a posh meal in our hotel.

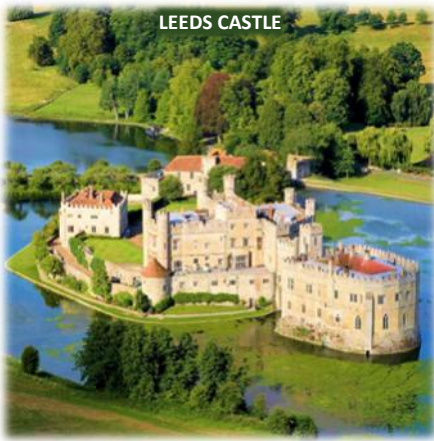
Sunday 5 **New Forest & Petworth**

(B,D) Leaving Bournemouth, we motor through the 140,000-acre **New Forest** – established in 1079 as a royal hunting ground by William the Conqueror, now home for thousands of free-roaming ponies. And our first stop is **The Weald and Down Museum** – where 1000 years of Sussex rural history is on display in over 50 historic buildings spread over 40 acres. That warm-hearted DIY TV show – *'The Repair Shop'* – is filmed here in a barn, so who knows what we might see today?

The award-winning hotel **'Ashdown Park'** (where we'll spend the next two nights) started life in the early 1800s as a private estate ... then a hospital for Belgian army officers in WW1 ... then a

school for novice nuns in 1920 ... then an American university ... then a training centre for bank managers ... then finally a hotel! And nearby Ashdown Forest is the woodland that inspired A. A. Milne's **Winnie The Pooh** stories ...

Tell that to your grandkids!

Before we get there we'll visit the lovely market-town of **Petworth** ... nestled in a 700-acre deer park, and crammed with charming nooks and crannies, historic buildings and art/antique shops.

Anyway, smarten up tonight, folks, because we're dining in elegance and style – a world away from the everyday – in the Forest Brasserie at '**Ashdown Park**'.

Yes, bring it on!

Monday 6

Sussex, Leeds Castle & Chapel Downs Winery

(B,D)

Are you in the mood for a castle? A fine-looking castle (not a tired old ruin)? A real, eye-popper of a castle, oozing with turrets and battlements and drawbridges and ghosts? Well, hurry up and finish your breakfast, because this morning that's what we're gonna see ...

Visitors never forget their first breath-taking view of **Leeds Castle**, rising majestically from the moat. And wait till you hear this castle's riveting story: the first stones laid down in 857AD ... its early centuries sprinkled with royal murders and sieges ... then home to six of England's medieval queens ... its most famous owner **King Henry VIII** ... its wartime housing of French & Dutch POWs ... then, finally, its transformation into an elegant 20th-century retreat for heiress, Lady Baillie.

By the time we're finished you'll realise why Leeds Castle is one of the most visited historic attractions in Britain. We'll enjoy the castle-gardens – we might have time for a proper English morning tea – and, if we keep looking up, we might even watch a fly-past by birds-of-prey!

But wait: there's more ...

This afternoon, we have a guided tour of the famous **Chapel Down Winery** – “with tutored wine-tasting paired with local cheese and artisanal crackers.” Sounds nice, eh?

When we're done, we return to the '**Ashdown Park Hotel**' to relax and fine-dine together again ...

Tuesday 7

Sissinghurst, Great Dixter & London

(B,D)

Today is our final day on tour in England. But our '**Up The Garden Path**' adventure would be incomplete if we didn't go wandering in two more of this country's “most famous” gardens.

Sissinghurst is an English country-garden dream. Once a space to grow vegetables for farm workers, it was transformed (during the 1930s) into “one of the finest plant and flower collections in the world.” From the White Garden, with small white blooms tumbling everywhere ... to the bold, bright Cottage Garden with its hot, hot colours ... to the Southern Cottage Garden with riot of reds and golds ... to prolific roses, blooming irises, and carpets of bluebells in spring and summer. Sissinghurst has beautiful





corners and secret nooks to burn!

Great Dixter is a high-energy garden with an arts-&-crafts appeal, where formal structure contrasts with wild creativity: *“a very special sanctuary where guests can take a deep breath and just be ...”* There’s everything here: from yew topiary to carpets of meadow flowers, from dazzlingly colourful mixed borders to natural ponds and waterways: *“a place of pilgrimage for garden-lovers from across the world ...”*

Later, we pack our bags and drive back into **London** for our final night together (hotel yet to be named) and our ***Midlife Madness Farewell Dinner!***

Wednesday 8 **All good things come to an end ...**

(B) These very special weeks have been a BLAST – don’t you agree? We’ve gone off the beaten track in some of the most ‘pinch-me-please’ parts of Ye Olde England ... we’ve got photos and memories, stories and legends to tell folks back home ... and we’ve made a bunch of new friends in the process! But the time has come (*the walrus said*) to say goodbye:

1. If you’re coming with us to Maastricht & André Rieu, your itinerary continues over the page (aboard a speeding *Eurostar* train to Brussels) ...

1. If you’re going straight back to New Zealand, you’ll be collected from our hotel (time to be announced) and transferred to London Heathrow Airport for your homebound flight (via Singapore) to Auckland/Christchurch ...

3. If you’re continuing your travels elsewhere, we’ll help you catch your flight, book your taxi, rent your bike or begin your hike – on time and with a smile on your face!

JULY 2026

Wednesday 8 **fast train to Brussels**

(B) We leave our London hotel and transfer to **St Pancras Station**, where a sleek **Eurostar** train waits to rush us to **Brussels**, capital of **Belgium** – headquarters of the European Economic Community (since 1958), and a city of many contrasts. Once we're through the UK border control and security, we settle into our comfy Business Premier seats, then speed out of London along the 'Chunnel' (the undersea channel-tunnel linking southern England with northern France).

En route we can relax in the *Eurostar's* lounge, enjoy a complimentary meal with champagne, and watch scenery as it flashes past our windows at a blurry 300kph! In just 1 hour 53 minutes we're in Brussels – where we switch to our coach for a 90-minute drive to **Maastricht** in southern Holland.

Our accommodation for the next two nights is in one of the city's beautiful hotels (*yet to be announced*). So sleep well, Kiwis – tomorrow's gonna be a TREAT!

Thursday 9 **charming Maastricht**

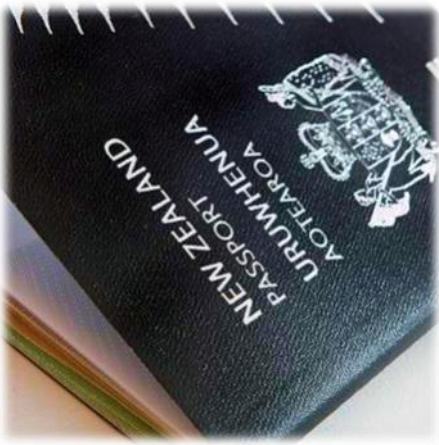

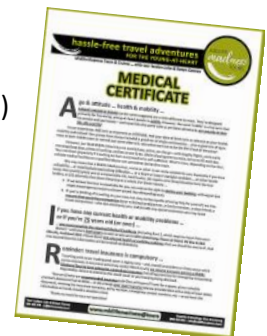
